Keynote Illuminates Path Forward

Mr. Kim Davis of the Walton Family Foundation headlined the "Summit on Childhood Success" last Tuesday, May 30th presented by the United Way of the Ouachitas Childhood Success Advisory Council, Child Care Aware of West Central Arkansas and First Step. Mr. Davis cautioned us in Arkansas to remember "we are better than we think we are," even if "we are not as good as we want to be". Representative Bruce Cozart, Representative Les Warren, Mayor Pat McCabe and Justice of the Peace Denise Marion responded to the keynote address in a panel moderated by Glenda Bean, Director of the Southern Early Childhood Association.

Over 80 school counselors, school nurses, administrators, child care providers and social service agency personnel attended the conference at National Park College. Pam Toler, ASU Childhood Education Coordinator presented brain research findings emphasizing the critical learning window in the first five years of life. Joan Manzilla, APRN of Healthy Connections described the impact of early intervention in high-risk pregnancies. Angela Duran, Campaign Director of the Arkansas Campaign for Grade Level Reading, closed the conference with practical means of improving literacy rates.
