The Webb Center is providing free meals every day to anyone under 18 years of age from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. through August 28, 2017. For those who are interested, one-to-one tutoring sessions are available after lunch three days a week. A mini-grant of \$1000 from the United Way of the Ouachitas supports the tutoring program.

All activities at the Webb Center were temporarily curtailed when the 25 year old HVAC system went out earlier this month. United Way joined with other local contributors to get the air-conditioning turned back on. Our Board of Directors approved the expenditure of \$1000 out of our Initiative Fund to help keep the children coming to the tutoring program despite the hot July weather.
